3.2 Appearance – Hair Boys

- Boys are to keep their face clean shaven, without any moustache.
- Boys must keep their hair short and neat.
 Hair must NOT reach the collar and cover the ears. Fringe must be short and neat.
- Sideburns must be neat and short (no longer than half the length of ear)
- Hair must not be artificially coloured.
- Line up Haircut, High & Tight Haircuts and Faded Haircuts are to be avoided.

Girls

- Girls must keep their hair neat and tidy.
- Long hair (touching the shoulder) must be tied.
- Fringes must not touch the eyebrows (long fringes must be pinned up or tucked behind the ears)
- Hair accessories must be simple and inconspicuous and be confined to the school colours.
- Hair must not be artificially coloured.

- Girls are allowed one pair of simple, inconspicuous earrings (one on each ear).
